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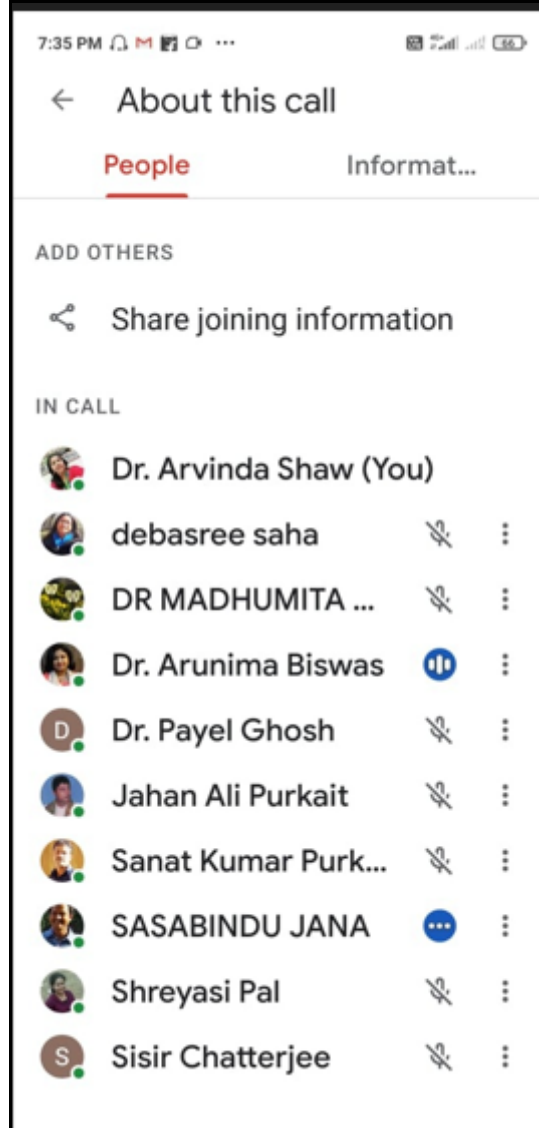

Detailed Minutes:

The meeting started after obtaining permission from Principal Sir.

Convenor Dr. Arunima Biswas welcomed everybody and read out and elaborated on the various agenda. She had queries about scope under NSOU and about industry linkage. Since, so far, in absence of an active career counselling cell, IQAC had made certain planning (as per NAAC requirements), she requested IQAC coordinator to first share his views. Then she requested all members to share their suggestions. Finally Principal Sir gave his observations.




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1. **IQAC Coordinator Dr. Sisir Chatterjee:** He mentioned that 'UGC XI PLAN MERGED SCHEME' included first proposal of Career counselling Cell or CCC. Vocational courses had been discussed in earlier GB meetings (before 2015): like Fisheries, Nutrition, Nursing, Soft skill and communication, with special emphasis on nursing; but they had not been implemented.

Banking tie up is being tried in some colleges to facilitate placement.

Space, facilities should be provided to the current cell by college when it reopens.

Programs should be arranged where Alumni job experience and achievements can be shared with current and outgoing students.

He suggested to the convenor that she should divide responsibilities among members ~ e.g.

- Assisting the non- creamy layer through skill building
- Jubosree prokolpo
- Employment information sharing
- Schemes for girl students
- Vivekananda swonirbhor prokolpo
- Coordination with the depts., especially big depts. like Bengali
- Record keeping

Professional training proposals~ Nandi foundation Pride classroom of Mahindra will be taken up post even sem exam.

2. **Dr. Debasree Saha** stressed on mentoring by depts. She suggested introducing specific job oriented training programs befitting our students.
3. **Dr. Arvinda Shaw** stressed on confidence build up to overcome shyness in students. Highlighted the importance of library e-resources. She too stressed on involving successful alumni in encouraging students. Suggested suitable skill building courses like beautician course. Discipline specific career prospects should be highlighted by each dept. during orientation. Suggested working with student welfare cell of which she is convenor.
4. **Dr. Madhumita Majumder:** Stressed on need to motivate our rural students who lack confidence. The cell should set up a system to share employment news, info, eligibility criteria etc., with students. Girl students often opt for nursing, but do not explore other fields like forest dept. trainings and placement, positions for lab assistant, trainings as given by RKM Narendrapur, Rahara etc. Stressed on info sharing by library.
5. **Dr. Payel Ghosh:** Stressed on Personality development, soft skill development. Emphasized on the role of mentoring regarding career opportunities from each dept. with focus on our rural students. Suggested to have an official Field officer or Placement officer to contact with different companies to get info on eligibility criteria, placement opportunities in govt. and non-govt. sectors. Equipment needed (desktop, printer, Xerox facility etc.) for this cell should be arranged by college. She also suggested collaboration with institutions like RICE and/or others.
6. **Dr. Jahan Ali Purkait:** Stressed on placement opportunities and creating job opportunities in streams suitable to the rural locality like Tourism, Irrigation, Archaeology, Fisheries, Forestry training. Suggested that college




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should provide room for the cell, preferably close to library. Wanted to have an arrangement with the training-givers so as to ensure campus interview and placement opportunities after training period. Suggested that Sir should contact local BDO office to know about govt. training schemes.

7. **Dr. Shreyasi Pal:** Stressed on student grooming and involvement of each dept. in subject specific career guidance through different programs, webinars. College should try to arrange campus interview from reputed companies.
8. **Prof. Sanat Kumar Purkait:** Said that our students come from very poor socio-economic background. Fund allocated should be utilised properly for student upliftment and career opportunities. Trainings on SSC, PSC jobs, other job oriented courses, vocational courses are essential. Previously many attempts to start different courses by external agencies had been declined. So College may adopt a policy to use internal human resources like fix weekly time (e.g. Saturday) to take free career oriented courses by our teaching, non-teaching staff with necessary expertise (e.g. teach MS Word, Excel, Adobe Photoshop, basic computer skills, dietician course etc.). Often different companies send offer to talk about their prospects to our students but may not be willing to pay; but if it benefits the students, Sir should consider their offer. Reputed companies may not be interested to come for campus interview in a backward college. Students should be taught to face interview board. Arrange mock interviews, demo videos. Library subscription for related periodicals should be increased.
9. **Principal Dr. Sasabindu Jana:** Stated that this was the first ever meeting of this kind of cell in college. All committee members should participate actively. Convenor should distribute responsibilities among the members. Stressed on importance of IQAC. After Sir's joining, no fund has come from UGC for CCC, like for career fair. But we owe it to our students to help them in their progress. He said that most depts. have not played active role in student progression after their graduation. Some teachers have played separate random roles, but there is no concrete all-inclusive policy or documentation. Many suggestions have come in this meeting. We need to choose 2 or 3 and implement them. Committee members have to dedicate defined time for the students. Many companies come solely for their own interest, for advertising. They often trick students in paying huge amount of money for their courses and do not provide permanent jobs. Such company offers have been and will be rejected. This is not aligned with our college motto. So committee should proceed with caution and keep in mind our local background.

Beautician course is a good proposal.

Entrepreneurship.... Small scale business setup..... Sir will give reference of proper guides for our students.

Tourism..... Sir can also provide reference from state govt. tourism dept., who can arrange training. Identify spots for tourism development.

Tailoring course, Carpentry course: NSOU vocational course is there.

Stretching and massage: high demand. Contact Abhijit babu. Angshuman and Sankar babu. Sir can refer.

Computer learning: certificate course can be arranged. Sir will refer.




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Dr. Arunima Biswas thanked everybody and suggested that a student survey be done once we can narrow down and ensure a few courses that we can actually offer and then introduce the ones with high demands. The others agreed.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the Chair.

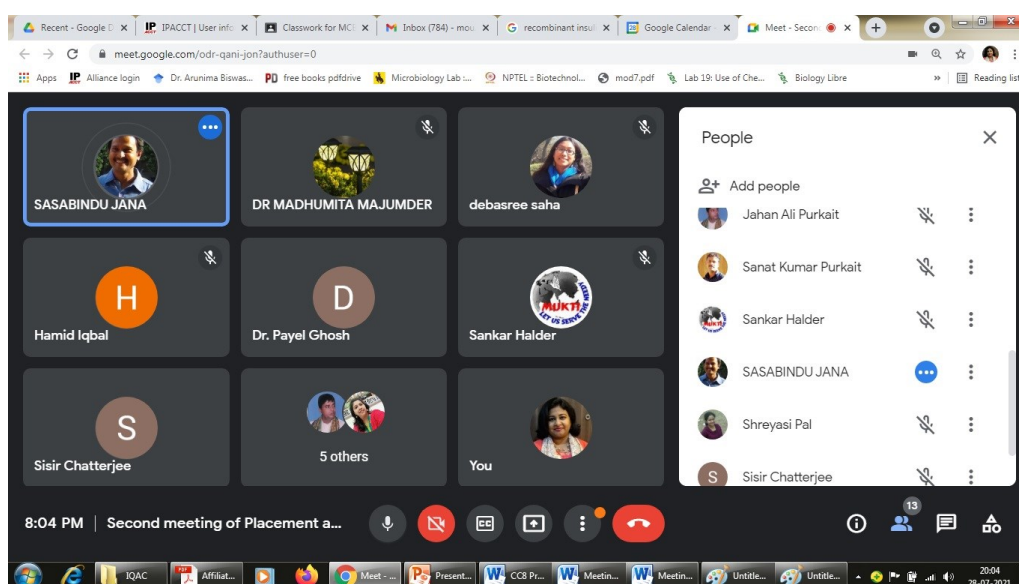

On behalf of our cell, I would like to submit a few requests as per common recommendations received in the cell's first meeting. Kindly do the needful to implement them as soon as possible.
