Feedback Analysis and Action Taken Report for Academic Session 2023-2024



Students Feedback for academic session 2023-24 was very important for our institution as it was first post NEP session in our academic institution:

Students were organized in campus with new enthusiasm in the period 2023-24. University examinations were also taken in complete normal mode. About 84% of our students were satisfied with teaching-learning experiences and they were also agreed that more or less 90% of the syllabus was covered in classroom in 2023-24. Our students are not still accustomed with e-resources but 85% of our students were acknowledged the supports and facilities of library. They were also appreciated our efforts within and outside laboratories for hands-on training, project works, tutorials and practical orientation.

More than 80% of our students were satisfied with student-teacher relationship in department. Our humanities students were not so ceremonially working in computer laboratory or with ICT infrastructure but around 68% students were acknowledged the favourable support system with ICT activities. Finally, our students were very gladly overwhelmed (77-82%) by the guidance of our teachers not only at the time of examinations but also throughout the session as mentor and philosopher. Our college was successfully arranged various collaborative activities for student's exposure and extensional support not only for academic orientation but also for personality and skill development. More than 80% students were acknowledged the arrangements and initiative.


Guardians were also appreciated our efforts within geographical and socio-economic compulsions of our location and communication disadvantages.






We are very hopeful that new academic and extensional support system for coming NAAC 2nd cycle will provide much more sustainability for our students in near future.




2. How much of the syllabus was covered in the Class?



















13) How would you rate the services offered by the college office ⁵⁶ responses




14) Community awareness programme are undertaken on regular basis to promote green environment




15) The initiative towards co-curricular activities helped in nurturing natural talents achieving accolades




16) Sports, Games and Gym facilities helped in maintaining good health and in participating in inter-institutional events.
