Every year large number of rural students (Girls and Boys) take admission in different courses of the college. The college provides concessional admission ship to all girls, SC and ST students as per the direction of the University and the WB Government. College also helps girl students to get different type to scholarship (National Scholarship, Kanyashree scholarship) provided by the Government. A remarkable enhancement in enrollment for girls students has been observed after the Girls' Hostel inauguration.
