A Webinar Series entitled '**Engaging Academia Online: Issues, Opportunities, Challenges**' was organised by Maheshtala College in collaboration with K K Das College and Raidighi College to spread awareness among students, teachers and other stakeholders on issues and academic engagements in the pandemic situation.

The inaugural lecture was delivered by **Professor Anupam Basu**, Alexander Von Humboldt Fellow, FINAE, FCS (Germany) and Director, National Institute of Technology, Durgapur on '**E - Learning: Prospects and Perspectives**' on **7th May, 2020**.

The next lecture in the webinar series was addressed by **Dr. Arindam Das**, Corporate and Creative Communication Specialist and Associate Professor in Business Communication, Alliance University, Bangalore on **14th May, 2020**. The topic of his lecture was '**Coronavirus Pandemic and the power of positive communication**'.

The last lecture scheduled originally for 20th May was postponed due to Amphan cyclone and held on **7th June, 2020** and was delivered by **Dr. Subir Maitra**, Registrar, Rabindra Bharati University. He spoke on '**Combating the Coronavirus Pandemic in Higher Education**'.

All the three lectures were held on **Zoom platform** and was attended by about 70 participants each day.

► The global coronavirus pandemic has created a new reality of grief and loss. Weddings, concerts, meetings, travels planned events, and more have been canceled in the wake of the virus, forcing us to process both individual and collective grief in the face of an uncertain future which we are powerless to control...The disruption in the normal routines and rhythms of everyday life contributes to a lingering unease and sadness that we are all feeling. Not only mourning the loss of thousands of lives, but we are also mourning the **loss of normalcy**, from seeing our co-workers to engaging in our mundane routines that we previously took for granted.

Definition of Positive Communication during coronavirus pandemic


► It is this meaning creation moment amidst collective grief during the pandemic that is positive communication to me. However, this definition of communication is **not being oblivious of the realities** of the pandemic world and its losses and grieving but rather resolutely and courageously facing it, moving **beyond its banal evil acceptance** in the expectation of **finding a meaning**. It is about sending and receiving messages/feedback that are **constructive, creative and collaborative** (participatory ethics not prescriptive ethics).
